

NSFC-CNS DON PATY FUND SUMMARY OF GRANTS FOR 2009

1. **CANADA CUBA PROJECT.** To assist trainees in Neurology, Neurosurgery and Clinical Neurophysiology by providing textbooks to the libraries in six major Cuban centres - \$43,000
2. **2009 CNSF CONGRESS.** To fund the Advances in the Neurobiology of Disease Course which focuses on, and is directed primarily to, neurology and neurosurgery residents; the main funding objective of the Don Paty Fund - \$25,000
3. **CANADIAN MOVEMENT DISORDERS GROUP.** To support the annual national residents' seminar on movement disorders - \$10,000

NSFC SUMMARY OF GRANTS FOR 2009

1. **2009 CNSF CONGRESS,** Distinguished Guest Lecture. To fund the DGL's expenses which are typically not supported from other sources - \$25,000
2. **CANADIAN ASSOCIATION OF NEUROSCIENCE NURSES.** To assist CANN in funding their annual Congress expenses - \$10,000
3. **ASSOCIATION OF ELECTROMYOGRAPHY TECHNOLOGISTS OF CANADA.** To assist in funding lectures and workshops at the AETC annual Congress - \$2,000
4. **CANADIAN ASSOCIATION OF ELECTRONEUROPHYSIOLOGY TECHNOLOGISTS.** To assist in funding lectures and workshops at the CAET annual Congress - \$2,000
5. **CANADIAN NEUROMODULATION SOCIETY.** To provide funding for abstract publications at the CNS annual Congress - \$1,500
6. **2009 CNSF CONGRESS.** To fund the 2009 opening plenary session's expenses which are typically not supported from other sources - \$25,000
